PLEASE NOTE: Clients are allowed 7 complete changes of clothing in their possession at all times. Any excess clothing items will be returned to the family or it will be inventoried and stored until discharge. This includes any clothing and or items that have offensive/inappropriate images, logos or writing.

**Unacceptable items include:** Cell phones (can be locked away), finger nail polish/remover, aerosol sprays, anything containing alcohol and gang affiliated clothing (hats/bandanas).

\*OMC will provide necessary hygiene items, towels & bedding.

\*\*Clients are allowed to keep in their possession any funds they bring in or which are given to them during their stay, however it is recommended that clients do not keep large amounts of money on them during their stay.
